

ORIENTATION EVENTS

TEMPORARY HOUSING

For students who have requested temporary housing: sign-in at the FIAP (30 rue Cabanis, 75014 Paris) takes place on Monday between 10:00 and 17:00 (if you reserve it, the airport shuttle takes you there directly).

HOUSING INFO SESSION

Students who are staying at the FIAP (temporary housing) and students who have requested to be housed by AUP, must attend the info session on Monday at 17:30 in the Combes building.

HOUSING PROCESS

As of Tuesday morning (after the Welcome Session), students who have opted to be housed by AUP have an individual housing

appointment with a housing counselor in the Combes building (the exact time is communicated by email the week before arrival).

DINNER AT THE AMEX

Come and meet your student advisor and your fellow incoming graduate students for dinner on campus.

WELCOME SESSION

Welcome to AUP! AUP staff meet and greet you and your fellow students at the American Church where you learn about the exciting week ahead of you.

YOUR STUDENT ADVISOR

All incoming students are assigned a student advisor. Student advisors not only accompany you and other members of your incoming group

to various orientation events, but also provide support throughout the semester. Think of these students – who know their way around Paris and AUP – as a resource and get to know them at check-in.

CAMPUS TOUR & METRO

Join an AUP staff member or student advisor for this comprehensive tour of AUP's campus, which ends at our Combes Student Life Center. Here you review prices, forms and the process to register for a yearly or monthly metro pass for the Paris metro, buses and RER.

LIVING IN PARIS

This critical session focuses on the essentials of living in Paris. We provide tips on banking, phone plans, IT services and health coverage while

also reviewing the many services and resources available to you at AUP.

AUP CHECK-IN & SERVICES

An AUP Admissions Counselor is on hand in C 102 (Combes building) to officially check you in. All graduate students start check-in at 9:00 on January 16. Arrive on time to review your pre-arrival checklist. We refer you to all the right AUP offices as necessary, including Student Accounting Services, the Registrar's Office, Student Immigration Services and other services. Once check-in is complete, you receive your student photo ID.

ACADEMIC ORIENTATION

Academic orientation takes place on Wednesday, with specific graduate program meetings allowing you to

ask questions about your course of study and any options in choosing classes.

PROGRAM MEETING

This group meeting is led by your program director. He or she will give you an overview of the program and explain the course offerings in detail. You will also learn about specific study trips, practica, and other interesting opportunities available to you throughout the semester. This meeting will help focus your interests in preparation for your individual academic advising appointment the following day.

DISCOVER PARIS TOURS

With AUP's campus located in the heart of the seventh *arrondissement*, finding your way around this neighborhood quickly becomes

second nature. With your student advisor, you will venture beyond this part of Paris to discover another side of the City of Light and get a better sense of what it means to be Parisian.

CONSENT: DEFINING OUR SOCIAL CULTURE

Defining a culture of respect, building a safe community and raising awareness of sexual assault and harassment issues through this consent education workshop led by AUP students and staff.

PARIS LIBRARY RESOURCES

Our librarians outline the various library resources available to graduate students at our own library, the Sciences Po library and other specialist libraries in Paris.

EVENING EVENTS

On Thursday, your student advisor will take you to their favorite Parisian restaurant. On Friday, graduate students attend an early evening cocktail with faculty on campus and then enjoy a night out on a *Bateau Mouche* as it cruises the Seine.

FINANCIAL AID & LOANS

Our resident staff experts on financial aid and student loans guide you through any bureaucratic tangles that you may have encountered. This session also covers work opportunities on- and off-campus, and useful information for students with financial awards.

CAREERS AND INTERNSHIPS

Our Careers Office outlines the range of services, workshops and

one-on-one mentoring sessions that are available to graduate students.

SAFETY: PARIS AND BEYOND

AUP takes the safety of its community and visitors very seriously. As with any university campus, especially in a large city, you must understand your role in maintaining your own safety. You will learn how to be aware of your surroundings and stay safe as you travel around Paris, as well as to other cities and countries while you are at AUP. AUP also makes the International SOS Assistance APP available to you for your security and safety.

January 18 | 18:00-20:00 | Combes building


